



Gwyneth

Sizes: Small, (Medium ,Large)

Yarn: 1 skein Worsted weight yarn, at least 100 yds

Gauge: 4.5 sts/1" in Stockinette st.

Needles: 1 – 16" 4mm (US 6) circular needle
 2 – 24" 4mm (US 6) circular needle
 1 – 5mm (US 8) double point needle (dpn)

Other materials: Stitch marker, tapestry needle,.

Abbreviations: CO – Cast on
 BO – Bind off
 St st – Stockinette stitch
 PSSO – Pass slipped stitch over
 K – Knit
 P - Purl
 St - Stitch

Instructions:

Using shorter circular needle, CO 120(126, 132) sts. PM, join into round, taking care not to twist cast-on. Knit until fabric measures ½" from cast-on edge.

Decrease round: Using one of the 24" needles, *slip 2 tog as if to knit, k1, pssso, rpt from* 20, (21, 22) times total. Using second 24" needle and rpt from * to * to end of round. [40(42, 44)sts)].

Next round: *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round. Repeat for 8 rounds total. (Optional: if desired, work ribbing section for longer length of wrist section.) Begin thumb gusset.

Round 1: k1, m1, k1, m1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 2: k5, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 3: k1, m1, k3, m1, k1, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 4: k7, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 5: k1, m1, k5, m1, k1, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 6: k9, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 7: k1, m1, k7, m1, k1, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 8: k11, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 9: k1, m1, k9, m1, k1, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 10: k13, p1, *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 11: *k1, p1, rpt from * to end of round.
 Round 12: Rpt Round 11
 Round 13: BO 12 sts in pattern using dpn; slip last st back to right needle point of circular, work in pattern to end of row, turn.

(Note: Begin working back and forth to create room for thumb webbing.)

Row 1: CO1, work in pattern to end of round, turn.
 Row 2: Rpt Row 1 without turning at end of row.

Join back into the round. Work in pattern for 9 rounds. BO loosely in pattern using dpn. Secure all ends.

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
