



## K&K Cap

Sizes: Small (Toddler), Medium (Child/Small Adult), Large (Adult)

Yarn: Worsted Weight Wool - we used Cascade Yarns Cash Vero

Gauge: 5 sts/in in stockinette stitch on larger needles

Needles: US 6 (4.00mm) 16" circular or dpns  
US 8 (5.00mm) 16" circular needle  
US 8 (5.00mm) dpns  
Or needles required to get gauge

Other materials: Stitch marker, tapestry needle, tape measure

Abbreviations: CO – Cast on  
BO – Bind off  
St st – Stockinette stitch  
YO – Yarn over  
K2tog – knit 2 together  
K – Knit  
St - Stitch

Instructions:

### Hem Facing:

Using smaller needles, CO 72 (80, 88) sts using long tail cast on method [Alternately, use provisional cast on of your choice]. Place marker to mark beginning of round and join, being careful not to twist.

K 10 rounds.

Next round: \*K2tog, YO; repeat from \* to end of round.

### Hem:

Change to larger circular needle.

K 9 rounds.

### Joining round:

Fold hem facing to inside of work. Pick up the cast on loop of first st from CO, place on left needle and knit together with the next st. Repeat, picking up on cast on loop and knitting together with each st of the round. [If using provisional cast on, undo waste yarn and knit each cast on st together with one st of the round.]

### Hat Body:

Continue in st st until work measures 5.5" (6.5", 7.5") from the picot edge.

### Crown:

Size Large only: \*K9, K2tog; repeat to end of round. (80sts)

Next and alternate rounds: K

Sizes Medium and Large only: \*K8, K2tog; repeat to end of round. (72sts)

Next and alternate rounds: K

All Sizes: \*K7, K2tog; repeat to end of round. (64sts)  
Next and alternate rounds: K

\*K6, K2tog; repeat to end of round (56sts)

\*K5, K2tog; repeat to end of round (48sts)

\*K4, K2tog; repeat to end of round (40sts)

\*K3, K2tog; repeat to end of round (32sts)

Next round: K2tog to end (16sts)

Next round: K2tog to end (8sts)

Cut yarn, leaving at least 5" tail. Using tapestry needle, run yarn through all sts, draw up tightly to wrong side of cap. Weave in ends.

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
