

Shower Mitt

One Size

Yarn: Plymouth Yarns 24 Karat, 1 ball

Gauge: 5sts/in stockinette stitch on US #6 (4mm) needles

Needles: US #6 (4mm) 24in circular needles, 2 pair

Abbreviations:

CO Cast-on

BO Bind-off

st, sts Stitch, stitches

K Knit

P Purl

Rpt Repeat

Dec Decrease

K2tog Knit two stitches together

SSK Slip, slip, knit

Lft1 Left leaning increase—Using left needle, pick up stitch two rows below last worked st on right needle and knit

Rht1 Right leaning increase—Using right needle, pick up and knit stitch below first st on left needle

Instructions:

CO 42 sts and divide evenly two needles. Join in round, taking care not to twist CO edge. Work K1P1 until piece measures 1 1/2" ins from CO edge.

Round 1: K 1 round

Round 2: *Lft1, K to end of first needle, Rht1, rpt from * to end of round.

Rpt these last two rounds 2 times more. K until piece measures 6 ins desired length.

Dec round: *K1, SSK, K to 3 sts before end of first needle, K2tog, K1, rpt from * to end of round.

Next round: K 1 round

Rpt these last two rounds 3 times more, then rpt Dec round 4 times more. Kitchen remaining stitches.

Note: Mitt will be small; this is to create a tighter fit since it will stretch once wet.
