



S I M P L E T R I A N G L E S H A W L

Basic bottom up triangular shawl, increasing every row

Materials: Claudia Hand Painted Yarns, Fingering Weight (100% Merino Wool, 109 yd), color Fantasy, minimum 6 skeins

Needles: 1- 32" Size US #6 (4.0 mm) circular needle;
1- Size US #8 (5.0 mm) double point needle (dpn)

Pattern:

Using circular needle, CO 1 st.

R1: Kfbf (3 sts.)

R2: K

R3: K1, Kfbf, K1 (5 sts.)

R4: K

R5: K1, Kfb, K to last 2, Kfb, K1

R6: K

Repeat rows 5 & 6 until there are 11 sts, ending with knit row.

Next row: K5, YO, Knit to end.

Repeat this row until desired size, making sure to have at least 3 times the length of the top of the shawl in yarn to complete bind-off. Using dpn, BO very loosely. Block to full size.
