

Easy Fingerless Mitts

Sizes: S(M,L) to fit hand sizes up to 7.5”(8.5”, 9.5”)

Yarn: Worsted weight wool

Gauge: 4.5 sts/in stockinette stitch on larger needles

Needles: US #6 (4mm) straight or circular needles – 1 pair

US #8 (5mm) straight or circular needles – 1 pair

Other materials: Tapestry needle, scissors, tape measure

Abbreviations:	CO	Cast-on
	BO	Bind-off
	st, sts	Stitch, stitches
	K	Knit
	P	Purl
	Rpt	Repeat
	K2	Knit 2 stitches
	P2	Purl 2 stitches

Instructions:

Using smaller needles, CO 30(34,38) sts, leaving an 8” tail. Knit 5 rows.

Purl 1 row.

Knit 1 row.

Repeat the last two rows until piece measures 4(4,4.5)” from CO edge, ready to work a Knit row.

Begin ribbing as follows:

Row 1: K2, *P2, K2, rpt from * to end

Row 2: P2, *K2, P2, rpt from * to end

Repeat these last two rows until ribbing measures 2”. BO in pattern very loosely, using the larger needle. Leave 12” tail.

Seam closed using tails and leaving opening for thumb.
